Biographical notes
Air Vice Marshal Simon John Bollom CB graduated from Southampton University in 1981 with an honours degree in mechanical engineering. Entered the RAF on a short service commission in the Engineering Branch. In Mar 89, he was promoted sqn ldr at BAE Warton to command the Eurofighter International Air Forces Field Team. In Jan 1992 he became the senior engineer on No 72 Sqn in Northern Ireland. 1994 became support authority for the Adour engine, before being promoted to wg cdr in Oct 1994 to become the programme manager for the Pegasus and Adour engines. Served for a year in MoD on the Helicopter Operational Support Study Team, a precursor studies of Joint Helicopter Command. Following Joint Services Defence College, he returned to the Eurofighter project at Abbey Wood, then the RAF Odiham Chinook Force. In Dec 2001 as the Director of Equipment Capability was responsible for battlefield helicopters. Joined the Tornado IPT in Jun 2003 and on promotion to air commodore became the Team Leader in Mar 2005. In Jan 2008 became Director Combat Air in the rank of air vice-marshal. In 2011 made a Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath.
Air Marshal Sir Kevin Leeson CBE was commissioned as a University Cadet in 1974, regraded to Pilot Officer in 1977 on graduation from the University of Manchester Institute of Science and Technology with a first class degree in Electrical & Electronic Engineering. Promoted to Flying Officer in 1978, and Flight Lieutenant in 1980. Worked on planning the support of the Eurofighter Typhoon electrical and armament systems. Promoted to Wing Commander in 1990. Commanded the Engineering Wing at RAF Marham. In 1996 he moved to Headquarters Strike Command, promoted to Group Captain in

1997, to manage the supply and engineering activities for the whole Tornado fleet. After graduating from the 1999 course at the Royal College of Defence Studies, Leeson again returned to the MOD, now as Group Captain then Head of Air Resources and Plans. Promoted to Air Commodore 2001, Air Vice Marshal 2004, Assistant Chief of Defence Staff - Logistics Operations, 2004. Assistant Chief of Defence Staff - Strategy and Plans 2007, promoted to Air Marshal and appointed Chief of Materiel - Air at Defence Equipment and Support in May 2009 joining the Air Force Board as Air Member for Materiel and Chief Engineer (RAF).

Air Vice Marshal Charles W Ness CB held a number of senior appointments in the Royal Air Force spanning strategic planning, acquisition and air safety. The latter half of his Service career saw him developing and leading major change initiatives associated with organisation redesign and business transformation. Became a Fellow of the Royal Aeronautical Society in 1998 and has since served continuously as a volunteer, supporting the Organisation's activity. In 2009 he became a Member of Council, was made a Trustee of the Society, and assumed Chairmanship of the Professional Standards Board. Companion of the Bath 2010.

Maj General Gordon Kenneth Messenger RM DSO Bar OBE. Born 1962. Appointed an acting lieutenant on a short career graduate commission 1983 transferring to a full career commission on 21 May 1986. Served in the former Yugoslavia in 2000 (Kosovo), for which he was appointed OBE. Promoted substantive colonel 2002. Awarded DSO for his leadership of 40 Commando in Iraq, including the initial assault on Al Faw peninsular, and an action against Iraqi armour at Abu Al Khasib. Joined the Joint Force Headquarters as Chief of Staff in 2004. Graduated from the UK Higher Command and Staff Course in 2007, promoted brigadier. 2008 he was appointed an aide-de-camp to the Queen. Served as the British Commander of Task Force Helmand, with 3 Commando Brigade deployment to Helmand province, in 2008-2009. Awarded a Bar to his DSO 2009 first member of the Naval Service to receive the DSO and Bar for over 50 years. Promoted major-general 2009, appointed lead spokesman on British operations in Afghanistan. 2011 Chief of Staff (Operations) at Permanent Joint Headquarters, Northwood.

Maj General David Mark Cullen OBE was commissioned into the Royal Artillery in 1982. Served as commanding officer of the 1st Regiment Royal Horse Artillery during deployment to Basra in Iraq in 2004, for which he was awarded the OBE. Appointed Commander of 12th Mechanized Brigade in November 2007, in which role he saw service in Afganistan. Director of Army Staff in December 2009 and Chief of Staff for Land Forces in October 2011.

Air Cdre Martin A Clark joined the RAF in 1979. His early tours were on Victor tanker, Nimrod maritime patrol and Tornado strike/attack aircraft, before serving at Headquarters Strike Command (HQ STC) as the staff officer to the 2-star responsible for all engineering and supply activity within the Command.

Posted to the Support Management Group at RAF Wyton, promoted to wing commander and the Engineering Authority for the aircraft's avionic and electrical systems. Commanded Engineering and Supply Wing at RAF Kinloss, 1998; obtained a Masters degree in business administration. Served in the personal staff of the first Chief of Defence Logistics in Bath, responsible for managing the Defence Logistics Organisation Change Programme and, subsequently, the Defence Logistics Transformation Programme. Moved to the Defence Procurement Agency in 2006, promoted to air commodore in August 2007, appointed Head Air Intelligence, Surveillance, Target Acquisition and Reconnaissance in the Air Support Operating Centre within Defence Equipment & Support. Joined the Military Aviation Authority (MAA) in June 2011 with responsibility for the technical certification of new aircraft and regulations across the Air domain.
