Sgt James Rodger DCM, MM 7 October 1919 - 7 October 2010
Led reconnaissance missions instead of officers against the Japanese in Burma

Sqn Ldr James Marquis DFC 16 October 1921 - 19 October 2010
Navigator decorated for low level attacks on Japanese supply lines in Burma and 58 sorties

Stephen Whitwell CMG, MC 31 July 1920 - 6 October 2010
Overcame polio to win MC at Battle of Orinoto, stationed in Austria when Cossacks repatriated to USSR

Robert Babington DSC 9 April 1920 - 12 September 2010
Naval aviator in Mediterranean theatre ♦and off Europe, and night fighters, sunk with HMS Dasher in the Clyde

Lt Commander Donald Macqueen MBE 12 November 1920 - 1 September 2010
♦Helped train more than 900 wartime naval pilots on carrier operations following service on HMS Illustrious</p> <p>Vice Admiral Sir Richard Peek KBE, CB, DSC 30 July 1914 - 28 August 2010</p> <p>Senior gunnery officer on ship suffering 5 direct hits from kamikazes who also commanded in Korean War</p> <p>
Lt Colonel David Rose DSO and Bar 23 March 1912 - 24 October 2010
Black Watch bayonet charge in British Somaliland and Second Battle of the Hook in Korea led to decorations</p>
